See can you name the All Stars in hurling and football from 10 years ago

1. I won my first and only All Star award this year. My club is Patrickswell.
2. This was my third of four All Stars. My club is St Lachtain's.
3. I won my only All Star and would win an All-Ireland with Tipperary three years later at wing-back. My club is Killenaule.
4. I won my second All-Ireland this year but my first of four All Stars. My club is James Stephens.
5. This was my fifth All Star of nine in total. Rated as one of the all-time greats, my club is Tullaroan.
6. This was my third and final All Star. I won four Munster titles, an Allianz League but never the All-Ireland. I played for Mount Sion.
7. This was my third All Star having also won Hurler of the year back in 1998. My club is Mount Sion.
8. Nicknamed "Brick", this was my first of four All Stars so far. My other All Stars were won at centre back and wing-forward. My club is Stradbally.
9. I won my second of three All Stars this year. The following year I would go on to captain my county to three-in-a-row All-Ireland wins. My club is Ballyhale Shamrocks.
10. I won Hurler of the year this year and these days can usually be found patrolling the sideline as a selector with my county. My club is Lismore.
11. This year I won my one and only All Star. My club is Ahane.
12. I serve in the Irish Army and this year won my only All Star. My club is Ballyduff Upper.
13. My club is Kilmallock and I won my first and only All Star this year. Unfortunately my inter county career was cut short due to illness and I retired at the age of 26 four years later.
14. This was my seventh of a record 11 All Stars. I captained my county to All-Ireland victory this year. My club is Ballyhale Shamrocks.
15. My third of four All Stars won in total this year. I never played minor with my county but would go on to win 8 senior All-Ireland medals. My club is Graigue-Ballycallan.

1. My third All Star, I made my debut in 2001 and am still goalkeeper for my county today in 2017. My club is Parnells.
2. I won my second of three All Stars in total this year. I was also named as Footballer of the year this year. My club is An Ghaeltacht.
3. My one and only All Star after some stand-out performances this year at full-back. My club is Lavey.
4. This was my second of four All Stars. My club is Bantry Blues and I would go on to captain my county to an All-Ireland title in 2010.
5. I won my third All Star this year and would win two more. I would also win the Footballer of the year two years later. My club is An Ghaeltacht.
6. This was my second and last All Star but would go on to play for another decade winning 5 All-Ireland titles in total. My club is Rathmore.
7. I won my only All Star and would go on to win an All-Ireland at centre-forward four years later. I play for St Brigid's.
8. I won my second and final All Star this year. In total I won six Leinster titles but never won the All-Ireland. My club is Raheny.
9. I won my fifth All-Ireland medal and my third All Star this year. Two of my younger brothers also won All Stars this year. My club is An Ghaeltacht.
10. My only All Star, I helped my county reach the All-Ireland semi-final this year. Navan O'Mahonys is my club.
11. My first All Star, this year I became the first man since Tony Hanahoe in 1977 to lift Sam Maguire twice. My club is Dromid Pearses.
12. I won my first of three All Stars this year, succeeding my father who won an award in 1979. I play for St Oliver Plunketts/Eoghan Ruadh.
13. This was my fourth of eight All Stars and this year I was also nominated for Footballer of the year. My club is Dr Crokes.
14. My one and only All Star having been nominated four times previously. A prolific forward, my club is Glenullin.
15. I helped my county reach the Ulster final this year and the All-Ireland quarter-final. I finished second in the championship scoring charts this year. My club is Magheraclone Mitchell's.
